SECRETARY'S SCRIBBLES

On the 27th March I sent the following email to those members with email addresses and it is self explanatory:

I am afraid that this is not good news. On Friday I went with Denise to see my specialist and after my lung function tests he advised me that he wanted me to go on to morphine, small doses to start with to help my breathing when it is bad, however also to start to get the palliative care nurse to visit. We are both shell shocked as despite the fact that we both knew this would eventually happen we were not prepared for it just yet.

We have no time scale but I get the impression it is a case of months. I have no intention of finding out any more than that certainly at this stage. I had a full CT scan today and see him in again in about 4 weeks. It is simply my emphysema.

I have every intention of carrying on as best as possible for as long as possible and to this end Brian McGrath has agreed to act as Assistant Secretary and help me whilst he also learns the ropes.

I am looking for someone to take on a similar role with Probe. The ideal candidate will have internet access and a very basic knowledge of Microsoft Word. The templates for the whole year are already done so it a relatively easy task.

Can I please ask that you let Denise and I carry on as usual, no sympathetic phone calls or fussing over me, we are finding it hard enough to come to grips with this on our own. Rest assured that if Denise and/or I require some help in the future we will let you know.

I can now add that today I saw my GP and he gave me the preliminary results of my CT scan which shows no new developments other than the fact that I have gall stones. No op is envisaged as they are not causing inflammation. My full results will be given to me on the 27th April.
