Smoked Ocean Trout & Chive Mini Frittatas

Prep: 15mins. Cooking: 20mins. Makes 30. Serves 12-14

50g butter

1 medium zucchini, finely chopped,

6 eggs

200g creme fraiche or sour cream, plus extra to serve

100g smoked ocean trout, finely flaked,

2 tablespoons finely chopped chives



- 1. Preheat oven to 180°C (160°C fan). Melt 25g butter in a frypan. Brush melted butter into 30 non-stick mini-muffin pans (1 tablespoon capacity).
- 2. In same frypan, melt remaining butter over medium heat. Add zucchini and cook for 5 mins or until tender. Set aside to cool.
- 3. In a bowl, whisk eggs. Stir in zucchini, creme fraiche, flaked trout and chives. Season, then spoon mixture into prepared pans.
- 4. Bake for 15-17mins, or until puffed and golden. Remove from oven and stand for mins. Turn out onto a wire rack to cool slightly. Top each with a dollop of creme fraiche and serve immediately.

(I cant see any reason why you could not use smoked salmon in lieu of trout)
