MINI SWEET CHILLI MUFFINS



- 2 tblsp sweet chilli sauce
- 2 tsp spreadable cream cheese
- 2 x 60g eggs, lightly beaten
- 1 1/2 cups self-raising flour
- 2 rashers bacon, finely diced 1 small (140g) zucchini, grated
- 1 green shallot (spring onion),
- 1 green shallot (spring onion), thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup grated tasty cheese
- 1/2 cup grated tasty encese 1/2 cup olive oil, approximately
- Grease 2 x 12-hole mini muffin pans. Whisk chilli sauce and cream cheese together in a small bowl then whisk in eggs.
- Sift flour into a large bowl, add bacon, zucchini, shallot and tasty
- cheese then stir in egg mixture and enough oil to form a soft batter.

• Spoon mixture into the prepared mini muffin pans and bake in a 180C preheated oven for 15- 20 minutes or until muffins are well risen and golden. Serve warm.

MAKES ABOUT 24

Muffins are best eaten warm but they can also be frozen in an airtight container for up to 1 month. Reheat frozen muffins in a 150C oven before serving.
