BILL REDMOND

Bill was born in North Melbourne in 1927.

He was educated at the South West Brunswick State

School and then the Brunswick Technical School. After leaving school he started work with a diamond ring making firm with a view to becoming an apprentice. Upon Japan entering the war, all intending apprenticeships were suspended in luxury trades by the Government of the time.

He then served a five year apprenticeship as an engineering patternmaker.

As a cricketer he started with the Brunswick 3rd eleven at the age of 14 and rose to become a 1st eleven player during the war years.

As a footballer he played in junior teams in the Brunswick area and then joined the under 19 team at Carlton in 1946. He was the first winner of their Best and Fairest award and graduated to become a senior player with the Carlton Football Team in their premiership year of 1947 and was an emergency in that grand final. After playing the first 5 games in 1948 his permit to play with Carlton was revoked as he was found to be residentially bound to North Melbourne. Nth. Melbourne refused to clear him back to Carlton so he chose to become a senior player with the Williamstown Football Team and played two seasons with them

including during their premiership year of 1949. Played 29 games and kicked 45 goals. During this time he was a member of the Metropolitan Fire Brigade for about 6 months. While at Williamstown, Bill met a young lady from Bendigo who was employed by the President of the football club. Her name was Mavis DOXFORD. They became engaged and Bill shifted to Bendigo in 1950. They were married in 1951 at St. Andrews in Bendigo. Unfortunately Mavis passed away in November 1997. They had one son Philip and two grandsons Robert and James.

Bill was employed at the Bendigo Ordnance Factory as a patternmaker from 1950 until 1956. He then joined the Victorian Police Force. After completing his training in Melbourne he was, after a short time, successful in gaining a transfer back to Bendigo where he was stationed until 1972.

During the 1950's Bill represented Bendigo in both cricket and football in country championships. He was a member of Golden Square and Sandhurst A grade premiership cricket teams. He was captain of the Bendigo Police cricket team when that team of veterans had an upset win over the youthful teachers College combination to win the midweek cricket premiership.

As a footballer he started in Bendigo with Eaglehawk. After two seasons with Eaglehawk he became Captain & Coach of the North Bendigo Football team in the Bendigo Association where he also won the Best and Fairest medal for that competition in 1954. He was a member of South Bendigo's premiership team in 1956. He was Captain & Coach of the Inglewood football team when they were premiers in 1958. He returned to South Bendigo as Captain and Coach of the 2nd Eighteen which he led to premierships 1959 and 1960. He was a premiership player with the Bridgewater Football Club in 1963. He retired at the end of the 1964 season at 37 years of age and was the leading goal kicker in the Loddon Valley Competition that year.

His career in the police force led to Bill attaining the rank of Sergeant and he became a law instructor in Melbourne at the Police Depot in St. Kilda Road but still resided in Bendigo. When the Police Academy transferred to Glen Waverly he remained as a law coordinator with the Police Cadets at the old Savoy Hotel in Spencer Street until the Cadets were disbanded by the Government in 1981. He then spent a short time in the Careers Office. He captained the Cadet Cricket team and was coach of the Cadet Football team in their mid-week matches. He retired from the Police Force in 1982. He is a recipient of the Police Long Service and Good Conduct Medal.

In 1953 Bill was initiated into the West Melbourne Lodge in Collins Street, and on the 8th of April 1954 he was raised to become a Master Mason. Bill became an affiliated member of the Composite Lodge on the 20th of October 1955. After the Composite Lodge handed in their Warrant, he with other Composite members joined the Golden and Corinthian Lodge on the 10th July 2001. He was installed as Master of that Lodge in 2008. Bill has also been a member of the Neangar Mark Lodge since the 13th of February 1957 and served as its master for two years. He has been a member of the Police Unanimity Club for over 50 years...

Bill is also a member of the Bendigo East Bowling Club and has been member of the Bendigo Probus Club since Aprik 2001. He also does a bit of ball room dancing.
