CINNAMON BANANA PANCAKES



Ingredients: 1 cup SR flour, 1 tsp cinnamon,

 $^{1\!\!/_2}$ tsp bi-carb soda, $^{1\!\!/_4}$ cup caster sugar

1 egg lightly beaten, 50g melted butter

1³⁄₄ cup buttermilk,

Topping: 2 large bananas sliced, maple syrup or warm honey, low fat ricotta.

<u>Method</u>: Sift flour, cinnamon, soda and sugar in a large bowl. In a separate bowl, whisk together the egg, melted butter and buttermilk. Pour the wet mixture into flour mixture and stir until smooth. In a non stick pan over a medium low heat add scoops of pancake mixture to the pan, cook until golden brown on both sides and cooked through. Place the cooked pancakes in a pre-heated oven 150 degrees, covered with foil until all pancakes are cooked. To serve place a couple of pancakes on each plate, add some sliced banana and drizzle with maple syrup or honey. Then serve with low fat ricotta. (TRIED AND TESTED BY MIKE AND DENISE !!!!)
