The AGM will be held at the 16th March Meeting. No guest speaker.

At our February meeting the guest speaker, Mr Wally Smilie, Community Education Officer for Ambulance Victoria was introduced by President Ern. Wally asked and answered himself the question when do we call an ambulance and the simple answer should always be do NOT hesitate if you have any thoughts at all that an ambulance might be needed. He then fully explained what happened whenever one makes a triple zero call or a 112 call for an ambulance. The prime advice he gave was to LISTEN CAREFULLY then ANSWER JUST WHAT WAS ASKED.

Mobile phone users were advised to have an entry in their phone book for a number to be called in case of emergency. Ambulance Officers, Paramedics and MICA Paramedics are trained to look for an entry under the name **ice1** .

Wally explained that not only Ambulance members receive free transportation in an emergency but also holders of a Pension Card, a Health Care Card or a Gold Card. In the case of road traffic accidents then the RTA pick up the bill for the use of any ambulance(s) needed. Anyone without cover from one of these could well face a very hefty fee for ambulance service eg an ambulance from McIvor Forest, Junortoun to Bendigo Base hospital was recently billed at \$2050

Several different aids/books/stickers were made available to members who were also made aware that a special booklet where you can write all your personal medical details is available through Rotary.

All in all a very informative talk and Wally was thanked by Ken Crouch and presented with a Probus Coffee Mug.
